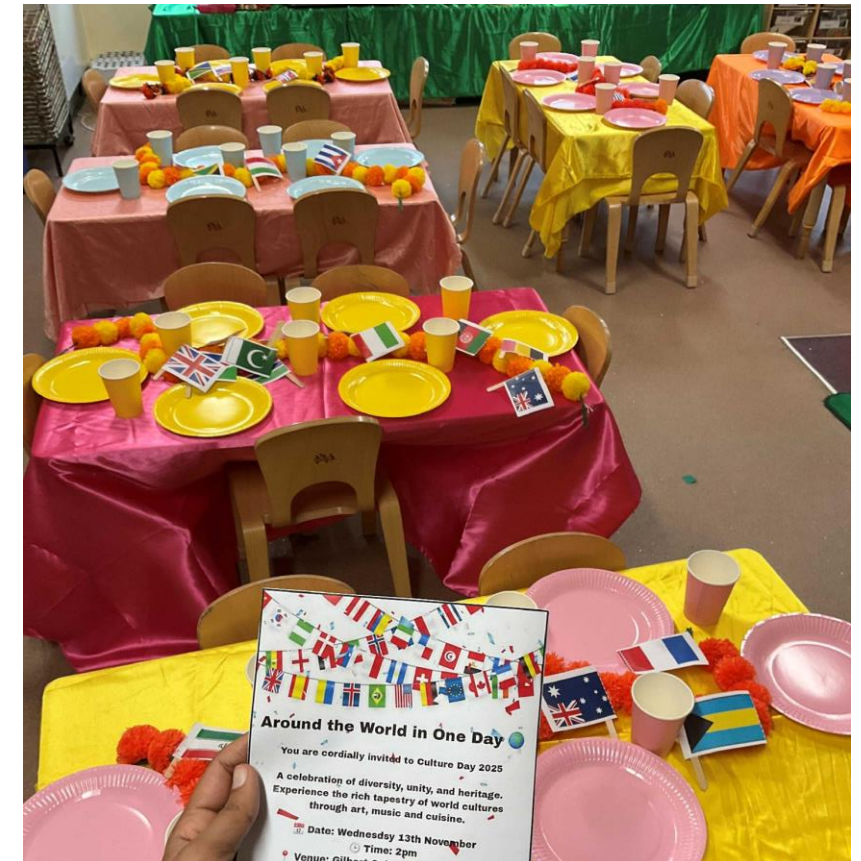


Experiences Pledge

Lower Key Stage 2

Every child will experience:

- ✓ A visit to a major London museum
- ✓ A river, canal or wetlands walk
- ✓ A hands-on history workshop (Romans, Egyptians, Stone Age)
- ✓ Cooking marshmallows outdoors
- ✓ A 'design and make' project (bridges, shelters, inventions)
- ✓ Learning a musical instrument
- ✓ Running a mile
- ✓ A whole-day cultural festival celebrating languages, food and traditions
- ✓ A visit to a theatre or live performance
- ✓ A school sleepover



Upper Key Stage 2

Every child will experience:

- ✓ A residential trip including outdoor adventure
- ✓ Learning to ride a bike safely
- ✓ A West End theatre visit or major London performance
- ✓ A water-based activity (canoeing, sailing, raft-building)
- ✓ A careers and aspirations day meeting real professionals
